APPRECIATING DIFFERENT GENRES OF MUSIC

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ABSTRACT

Our resource, titled, 'Appreciating different genres of music', is a project that aims to educate and raise awareness to Singaporean teenagers about the uncommon genres of music, besides the one they are currently exposed to (mainstream pop music). Through our package, we hope to encourage the appreciation and love for different genres of music on a deeper level, such as learning the origins, history of it. Teenagers thus can reap the benefits of listening to music and become more musically inclined. Our package consists of a website and a board game quiz. Our website features comprehensive yet important details of the origins, musical characteristics, musical artists and songs of various genres. We sourced various websites, to find the best details, and to paraphrase it in a way such that all teenagers could understand the knowledge we wanted to share with them. The genres that we covered are Rock, Soul, Funk, Blues, Country and Reggae. Lastly, we have also included tips and guides for musical composition, to further and deepen teenager's interest for music, so that they may one day become a musician as well. Our board game quiz is a fun and interactive board game, that allows students to learn in a fun and enjoyable way.

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 Rationale

We chose to create such a resource due to the music culture among Singaporean teenagers. Most of them listen to pop music. This can be seen on Spotify charts or local radio charts. If they continue to only stick with pop music, they will miss out on a lot of other unique and enjoyable music genres that they could add to their playlists.

Teenagers may also find other musical genres much more pleasant than pop music. They will thus be less musically inclined, which will not be helpful as music is immersed into their daily lives.

1.2 Objectives

The objectives of our project were

- To create awareness amongst teenagers on other less popular genres of music,
- To encourage the appreciation and love for different genres of music
- To let teenagers to appreciate music on a deeper level

- To allow teenagers to reap the benefits of listening to various genres of music.
- Lastly, to allow teenagers to become more musically inclined.

1.3 Target Audience

Teenagers aged 13 to 16. (Sec 1 to Sec 4)

1.4 Resources

The resource created for this project was a website consisting of detailed explanation of 6 musical genres (Country, Reggae, Soul, Blues, Funk and Rock). For each genre, we included the history, sub genres, songs, musical features and artistes. We also included a Song composition section and bibliography section. For our board game, it is called 'Superstar Singer'. The rules of the game is:

Each player choose 1 of the 6 genres.

Goal: To win, form a row, a column or diagonal of 5. You can also win by having more points than your opponents at the end, after both players occupied all genres. You can also win if you block all of your opponent's available pathway.

Each player can choose to place a card from the previous tile 1 step diagonally, horizontally or vertically.

All players start from the bottom.

They answer one questions related to the genre they land on for each tile they move.

Players can move to other tiles to block other players, by placing their cards on the tile.

Points system:

Player's Genre-1 point

Other genre-2 points

Opponent's genre-3 points

Missions:


After completing certain tasks, player could earn music contracts, helping them advance to the top and become a superstar singer.


3.METHODOLOGY

3.1 Needs Analysis




WHAT IS YOUR AGE?




DO YOU LIKE MUSIC




How often do you listen to music?




What is the main genre of music you listen to:




How often do you listen to the following genres of music?




How often do you listen to the following genres of music?




Are you familiar with most of the music genres style, background and history listed above?

3.3 Development of Resources


For the website, we went to online websites to research on information for the various genres and its singers/artistes. For the songs, we got it from YouTube. These songs are all the popular songs or classics for each genre (some featured in movies) so that teenagers could relate and learn to enjoy each genre better. The information that we got from websites were paraphrased in a simpler way so that it will be easier to understand. We then compiled the information in Google Docs and summarized before adding them

into the website. As for our board game, we got our pictures from the websites and printed them out. We then pasted the pictures onto a cardboard and wrapped it with a plastic wrap afterwards. The board game was inspired by other games such as tic-tac-toe, Risk. We then created an original game based on these games. We also printed out game cards for the board game. Lastly, we also consulted our mentor often, to get her approval. We listened to her advice and added some of our own knowledge into the resources.

3.4 PILOT TEST


Website Pilot Test

A pilot test was administered to teenagers aging 13-16 years old. We conducted a survey to see whether our website is useful for them. First, they viewed and browsed through our website. Then, questions regarding our project was asked and many of them were able to answer our questions correctly, showing that our resource was useful. Such questions are related to music. Generally, all the feedbacks were positive, and they said they might recommend it for others to use.




Whats your age

22 responses




How much do u know about music

22 responses




The emotion which a blues song could bring

Board Game Pilot Test

We then conducted our second pilot test, to test the feasibility of our board game. We explained the rules to the participants, then they started to play the board game. To progress in this board game, people have to answer music related questions. Some were able to answer the questions, while others got it after few tries. People found the board game suitable for teenagers, interesting and felt that they gain some musical knowledge.



Some feedback given:

“I feel like this board game is quite a good idea.”

“This board game actually helps quite a lot in knowing more about the genres.”

“This is definitely a good way to refresh your memory about music.”

“Maybe you guys should add more questions and special cards.”

“This is quite fun.”

“I think I know more about musical artistes after this game.”

“Did not really have the time to complete the whole game, but I liked the idea of it.”

“You guys should make the cards smaller.”

What have you learnt through this game?

“I learnt more about Stevie Wonder, and remembered his album history.”

“I learnt the difference between heavy metal and Rock.”

“I now know which genres has call and response.”

“I now know some famous country and rock songs.”

“I know that Country music originated in the Appalachian Mountains.”

4. OUTCOME AND DISCUSSION

The project received generally positive feedbacks from the judges as well as some of our friends, however there is still room for improvements. Some of the judges wanted the websites to have more songs, more images, and something to further incite their interest.

We decided to follow and added more songs and images, and made our website seem less wordy. We also added a section on music composition, so as to further improve musical knowledge for teenagers. It includes tips to compose music and how to write a simple melody. It is made for teenagers to understand. As for our board game, we decided to add more questions, special cards so as to make it more exciting.

5. CONCLUSION

To summarize, our project 'Appreciating Different Genres of Music', is definitely a fun yet challenging project that we had embarked on. The project is fun as it explores on songs and music, a common interest that many teenagers share. The project is challenging as we must put in many hours of work, find time to meet up, do a lot of brainstorming, paraphrasing, gather a lot of information, and also come up with interesting ideas to educate teenagers.
