## **1 Introduction**

### **1.2 Objectives**

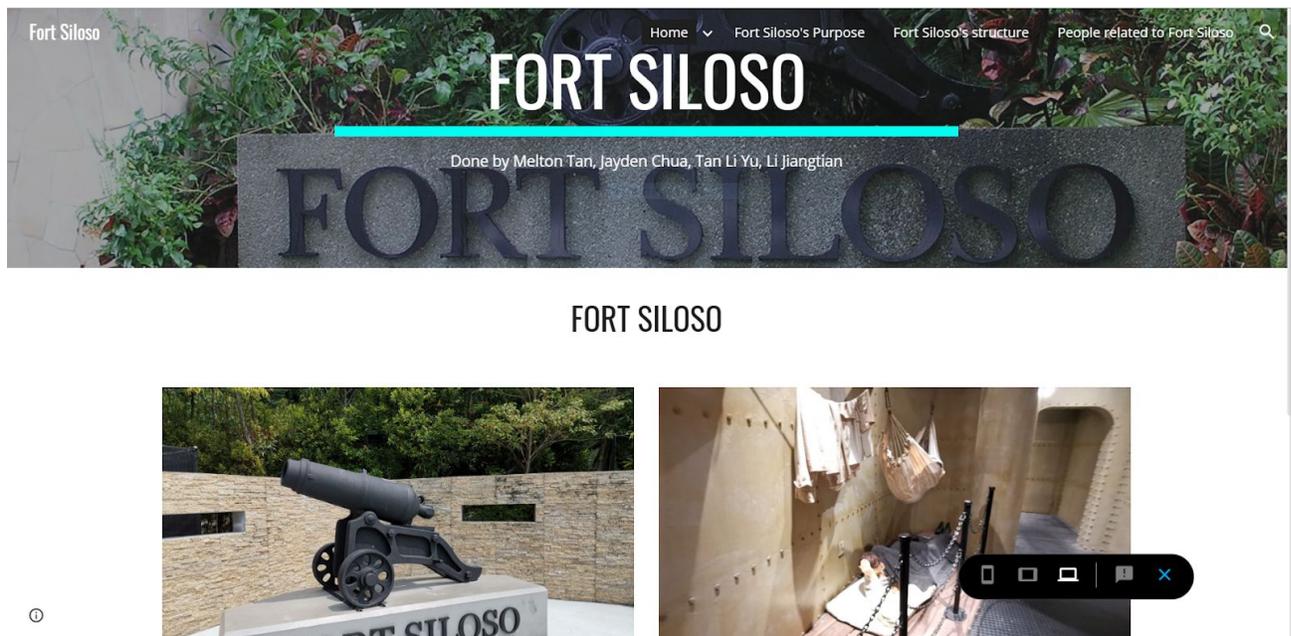
We aimed to raise awareness of Fort Siloso and its history and help students better understand Fort Siloso.

#### **3.2 survey results**

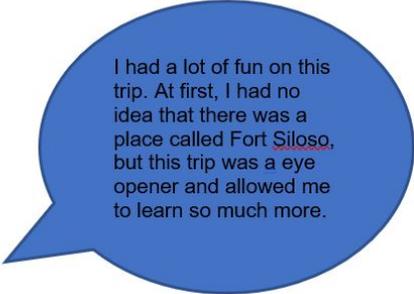

#### **3.3 development of resources**

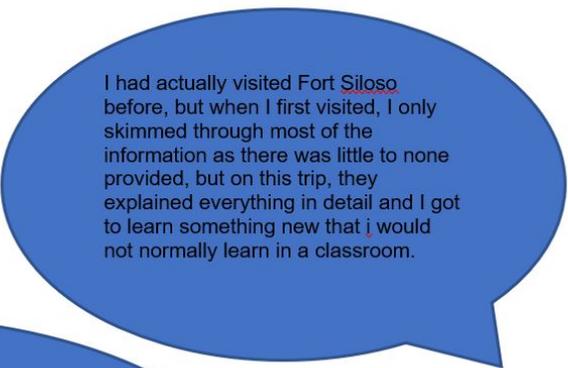

### 3.4 pilot test

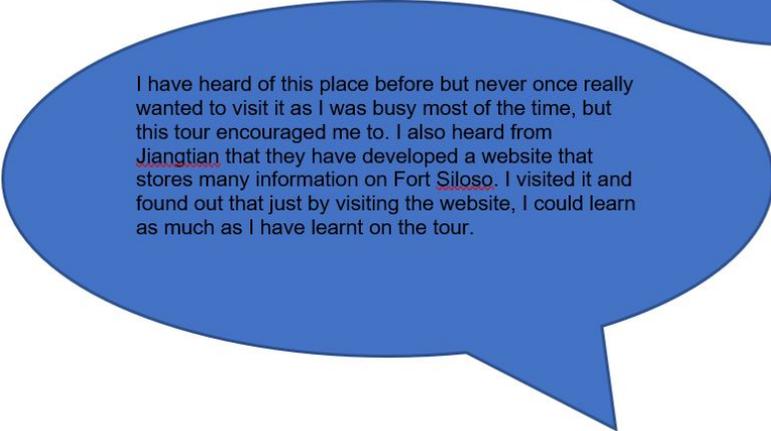
